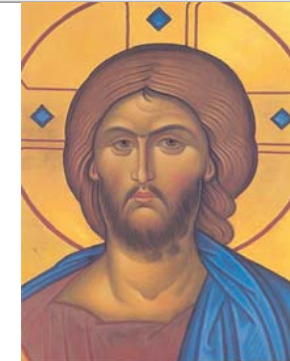

Community Grants

The annual City of Port Phillip Community Grants ceremony took place on Wednesday. Community grants aim to promote social inclusion, increase participation and strengthen connections. They recognise that local organisations are embedded in our community and have our fingers on the community pulse and an understanding of where need lies.

At South Port UnitingCare we were fortunate to receive four grants. One will help us to run Skooters which is the group for people who use motorised wheelchairs and scooters, two other grants will be directed at running specific community events and the fourth is a project that will enable local community emergency relief providers to improve the effectiveness of the delivery of relief services in our area. Overall the high level of success we had with our applications is recognition of the work we do in the area and our track record in delivering results when we have received grants in previous years.
