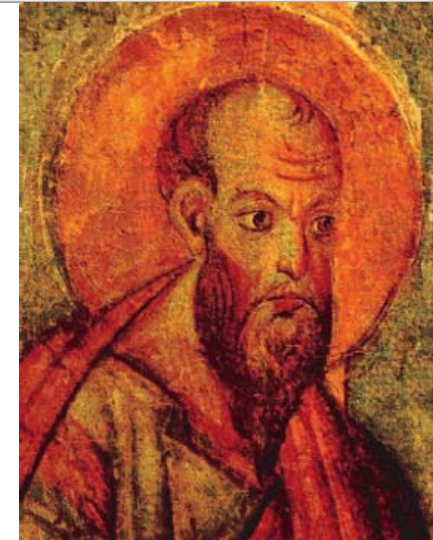

### **The 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Homelessness Memorial 2010**

The Annual Homelessness Memorial provides the opportunity to pay tribute to people who survived on the street and have now lost their lives. It is an event that stirs mixed emotions for those who attend, with respect and sadness being prominent feelings shared by all.

Unique stories are shared, each bringing to life the characters and the events that influenced the circumstances that caused one person or another to be without a home. Similar themes of long term homelessness caused by family breakdown emerge. Many years of living without an income, shelter, regular and healthy meals, family or friends contribute to what makes homeless people most vulnerable.

South Port UnitingCare are in a privileged position to be able to connect with homeless people and able respond to their immediate needs. We see a number of people who are experiencing short term or long term homelessness and we provide food, food vouchers, clothing and blankets as well as personal support and information to help to alleviate their difficult situation.

A permanent memorial has been installed in the Peanut Farm Reserve, St Kilda to honour those who have died as a result of homelessness.
