Behind the Scenes – well sort of...

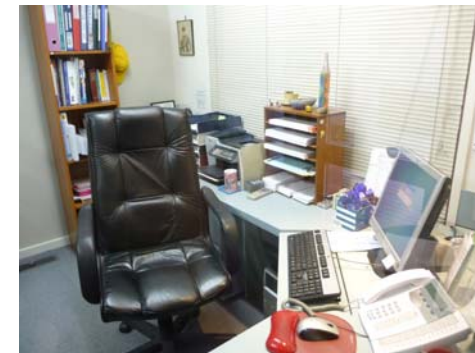
